### Recent Action of the Church Board

- May's board meeting was for the purpose of vision and planning. We discussed the nomination process, the upcoming finance committee budget meeting for 2008/2009, new members, baptism, daycare, staff relations, and how to deal with our growing pains in the 11:00 AM service and preschool.
- A new sketch was shown as a possible long term building plan to accommodate our growth.
- The 8:30 and 11:00 services were discussed at length. All of our current growth has been from the 11:00 service and the 8:30 service has fallen and seemed to have established a plateau of about 120 people with no new growth since going to the different style services. No decision was made but Pastor Blank encouraged the board to fast and pray for a solution to the over-crowding in the 11:00 service and the unused space in the 8:30 service.
